THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION COHORT PROGRAM

EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS AND ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (ESEE) PROGRAM (2 YEARS)

80 credits total: The Dual Preparation Program requires 14 more credits than the General Education Program

MUST take BEFORE program

SPED 304 Foundations of Inclusive Schooling (Elem. Emphasis - 3)

Required and STRONGLY recommended to take BEFORE the program

Elementary Education Emphasis Courses (9 credits)

1. EDEF 310 Education in American Society (3)
3. EDEP 311 Psychological Foundations (3)
4. ITE 360 * Introduction to Multicultural Education (3)

* EDEF 360 also meets this requirement

Before you begin the cohort program, work with your Office of Student Academic Services (OSAS) Advisor to schedule the above **required** Elementary and Special Education Emphasis courses. Some of these courses may be offered in the summer.
