<sup>3</sup> Sample rotation schedule for 7 Activity Centers (AC) and 5 student groups and 20 to 35 students (if there are only 30 students just leave the bottom row for each color group empty, and similarly if there are 25 or 20 students). Note there are more Activity Centers than Student Groups. The number of rotations equals the number of ACs. We suggest 4 rotations daily. On “A” days, students do rotations 1, 2, 3 and 4. On “B” days, students do rotations 5, 6, and 7. The teacher is free to float to assist individuals during the final rotations on “B” days.
