PBCTE–Elementary is designed for students who possess a baccalaureate degree and wish to obtain eligibility for a license to teach grades K–6.

Admission & Application Requirements

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 from all postsecondary institutions attended
- Completion of *SPED 304: Foundations of Inclusive Schooling* with a passing grade of C or better
- Bachelor's degree from an accredited and UHM-recognized four-year institution of higher education
- Minimum of 40 hours of current documented group leadership with elementary-aged youth (grade K–6) within the past five years
- Demonstrated verbal and nonverbal competence through Personal Admissions Interview(s)

Content Knowledge Requirement

Must meet one of the following options

- Passing score on licensure test adopted by the Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board (HTSB) in the content field; or
- A minimum of 9 credits in each of the four content areas (Math, English Language Arts, Science, Social Studies) with a minimum GPA of 2.75 in each content area
