The Master of Education in Teaching (MEdT) program is a two-year, field-based program designed for those pursuing a career in teaching who have earned baccalaureate degrees in fields other than education. Upon successful completion of this Master's degree, candidates will be recommended for an initial teaching license to the Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board to teach elementary (K-6), secondary (6-12), or Hawaiian Language Immersion (K-12) in a general education classroom. Programs offered at the secondary level are English, Hawaiian Language, mathematics, science, or social studies. Candidates in the dual secondary and special education cohort will also be eligible for a mild/moderate special education license.
