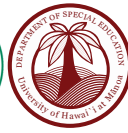

CLASS TYPE & PROGRAM FORMAT INFORMATION	ONLINE/HYBRID PROGRAM: Primarily online courses with up to two face-to-face meetings each semester. Online courses may include synchronous class sessions in the early evenings. Neighbor island candidates travel to Oahu on select Saturdays; some financial support is provided to assist with this travel. Face-to-face meetings will include an option to meet online for candidates outside of the state.		
STIPENDS & FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES	MERIT-BASED STIPENDS: Candidates taking the BCBA course sequence as part of our Master in Special Education are eligible to apply for departmental merit-based stipends, based on available funds. Receive up to \$8,000 total, based on merit as evaluated by transcripts, GPA, letters of recommendation, and full-time enrollment.
