- Ping Yip and Jong Hung Chan Award \$2500: AY2024-2025 is the inaugural year for this award which recognizes one fulltime graduate student in an area of study focused on achieving harmony among mankind by peaceful means and who, as an individual, exemplifies moral character, strength and integrity through personal or public behavior. A certification from the student's Graduate Chair verifying in what ways the student meets the award criteria is required.
