Passing score on the Praxis Content Knowledge Test or 30 credits of content coursework (subject to transcript evaluation and minimum GPA requirements). Students must submit student teaching applications by September 15 for Spring graduation and February 15 for Fall graduation.

Taking KRS 406 and KRS 405E and/or KRS 405S is dependent on level of teaching licensure desired: Elementary or Secondary (12 cr total). If K-12 licensure is desired both practicum courses and residencies (24 cr) are required. KRS 405S, KRS 405E, and KRS 406 require a minimum of B or better . Both courses must be successfully completed in order to become eligible for certification and licensure.
